

School regulations of the OBS Bad Fallingbostel

Preamble

Everyone should feel comfortable and contribute something in OBS Bad Fallingbostel

In order to achieve this, there are rules for togetherness that must be followed.

We try to provide a peaceful and friendly tone in the school. The greeting is part of it.

We treat each other fairly and we do not harm, hinder nor harass anybody.

We renounce violence and always try to settle conflicts through talking.

Principles

1. I want to get treated with respect by others and I will also treat other people with respect.
2. My opinion should get taken seriously. I will also deal with the opinions of other people and try to understand them.
3. I want to experience everyday school life without fear, and I will also never act in a way that other people get afraid of me.
4. Nobody should laugh at me, insult me, hit me or in any other shape of form damage me. I will also never use physical or verbal violence during a conflict.
5. I expect the atmosphere inside and outside of class to be an atmosphere that I can work well and also feel comfortable. This includes encouraging and helping one another. Nobody should be excluded.
6. I want to visit a school that is clean and beautiful with well-maintained facilities and also help shape it. That's why I take care of all materials and furnishings with care.
7. I want our everyday school life to operate well and therefore I will also take on tasks for the school community.
8. Environmental awareness is important to me. That's why I use environmentally friendly materials, use water and energy sparingly and separate the waste.
9. I know that all of the wishes and ideas I have listed can only be implemented if the cooperation between teachers, parents, pupils, and staff works well. That's why I support this collaboration.

Teaching and classrooms

- The lesson starts and ends on time. The teacher ends the lesson.
- Pupils that have lessons in subject rooms (scientific rooms, music room) must wait in the forum. The respective teachers will take them from there and send them to the class.
- Pupils have to wait before the start of physical education in front of the gym anteroom. The changing rooms will only be entered if the teacher has given permission.
- If the teacher is not in the classroom ten minutes after the lesson has started, a pupil can go and ask in the office.
- Lessons are working hours. This can only be successful if disruptions are avoided. The use of disruptive electrical and electronic devices is not permitted. The teacher is entitled to take such devices away.
- Every teacher is obliged to have the classroom cleaned up at the end of a lesson. The students are obliged to comply with this request.
- In order to contribute to saving energy, the windows should be closed, and the lights should be switched off when the lesson is ended.

Behavior during breaks and free time

- The pupils leave the classes in the two big breaks.
- The pupils do not leave the school-building during the 5-minute break (except when they have to change classrooms)
- During class times, the rear playground area is not a place for students to stay.
- Pupils may only leave the school-building with the permission of a teacher.
- Due to the danger to other pupils, snowballs or other objects must not be thrown.
- Everyone can positively influence the reputation of our school through their willingness to learn and their appearance in public. This is particularly possible through prudent behavior on the way to school, on public transport, during pupil internships and at school events.

General rules of conduct for the pupils

- Pupils are not allowed to smoke on the school premises (decree of the Minister of Education dated January 9th, 1989).
- It is forbidden to bring weapons, fireworks, drugs, and alcoholic beverages to school (decree of the Minister of Education of 07/29/1977).
- School facilities and equipment must be treated with care. Anyone who causes damage must pay a monetary sum for it.

- Visitors must check themselves in at the secretary. Visiting other children and teenagers in class is only possible in exceptional cases where the teacher must agree upon it.
- We pay attention to cleanliness and order; we separate the waste, we use water and energy sparingly.
- Everyone is responsible for the cleanliness of the school. Pupils have to obey the teacher's request to remove dirt, even if they were not responsible for it.
- We do not wear hats inside the school-building.
- No chewing of gum is allowed inside the school.
- Video and audio playback devices of all sorts (e.g., MP3-player, CD-player, and mobile phones) are not allowed to be brought into the school. If you break this rule, then the devices will be confiscated. The parents can pick them up again at the school administration.

Measures in the event of violations of the school rules

- In the event of violations of the school rules, the school can use appropriate educational methods.
- In the event of repeated or serious violations, the class leader applies for a class conference in accordance with § 61 NSchG to determine the disciplinary measure.

Final remarks

- This version of the school regulations came into power by resolution of the general conference of May 13th, 2002, supplemented by the general conference resolution of March 27th, 2006.
